Shotgun Sports: 5-Stand starts Thurs., Sept 2nd and will run on Thursday's for six weeks. Five Stand is a type of shotgun sport shooting similar to sporting clays, trap and skeet. There are five stations, or stands and six to eighteen strategically placed clay target throwers. Shooters shoot in turn at various combinations of clay birds. Skeet and Trap will also be open – we will have shells for sale (for rounds shot at TCCC only). For those who may not know, the Skeet field has voice-activated throwers and the Trap Field has easy to use Canterbury Voice Controllers. Come join us on Thursday evenings 530p to 8p or Sunday's 1p to 4p.

USPSA: USPSA match Saturday, Aug 28 and Sept 25. They are PCC matches and all divisions are welcome - all paper [classic IPSC] and static steel targets. You do not need to be a USPSA member to participate! It is good general practice too.

<u>3-Gun</u>: Saturday – Sept 11 – Shotgun and PCC Bonanza! Three shotgun divisions: Pump, Practical and Open. Two PCC Divisions – Full size/Open and Sub Gun.

<u>CPL</u>: Classes are held every month at TCCC - Next Class Sat., Sept 4. Sign up on our website. Questions contact the instructor. Have a private group interested in a class? Choose your date, class size minimum is 6.

Reminder to the Membership when there is a scheduled match or event – Bays that remain open for general membership use are Bays 3, 4, 9 and 10. Check the website calendar to know when there are scheduled events, because we have groups that use the facility for tactical trainings, besides matches. These events should be on the calendar so the general membership knows to seek out Bays 3, 4, 9 or 10. TCCC Membership

Membership to TCCC is 7 days a week, 9a to 9p. Current members enjoy covered buildings for protection in inclement weather; a 300-200-100 yard bay, tactical bay, pistol bay for practice under lights for when the days grow short again. We offer Skeet / Trap on Thursdays and Sundays – with fully lighted fields. Fall is the time different groups like to have a group outing – whether its on a skeet field, 5-Stand field or pistol bay, we do accommodate special outings – just ask! The Business Office is open on Thursdays 530p to 8p, and Sunday afternoon 1p to 4p. We encourage applying for Membership on our website however, during business office hours we will accept your paper application in person. Membership remains at \$50 for current year with a \$20 initiation fee, or \$100 for 2-years (waives initiation fee). New Members must attend orientation, receiving a new member packet, membership card/gate key, rules review and grounds tour.
