Rules of the Range: New safety implementation at the Rifle Range (aka 300 yard range). We have signage mounted on two sawhorses. As a safety measure, the sawhorses need to be set out and plainly visible if you venture downrange – alerting shooters that there is a man downrange. If you see the sign set out, that is your warning not to shoot until shooter returns to the building. Thank you Bob Leavitt for improving safety features at the range!
